

A FRENCH MOTHER'S GRIEF

We have been in contact with a distraught mother in Paris who has been through years of trauma trying to secure the return of her daughter who is being held in Mauritius. CTMI's hand is very much in this story.

Sabrina's story in brief:

- She is a French citizen, born in France
- Her family were drawn into CTMI in Paris when her mother was very ill after an accident. Her grandparents are involved in CTMI in Mauritius. The grandparents were visited on a holiday when Jahina was 13 and she was introduced to CTMI, in Mauritius, being forced to attend many meetings.
- When back in France her sister left the home in the south of France and stayed with a CTMI family in Paris while studying. Sabrina experienced psychological and physical abuse at home (she believes her mom rejected her from birth – even telling others she was adopted). She shared this problem with church members in Paris and team Hardy decided it was best she move to Mauritius to study. So at 15 she moved in with Agnes and Leonard Boy – CTMI members. However, she became a thorn in their side as she did not conform and asked many awkward questions about articles in the press. (We know all too well how such are treated) She was close friends with the Alladee family and was devastated when her best friend, Assia Alladee, simply disappeared with her siblings. (See that story in Carte Blanche post here on pg 34 - <https://www.ctmiconcernedparents.com/wp-content/uploads/2018/10/Miki-Hardy-Exposed-Deceit-and-Deflection-on-Carte-Blanche.pdf>) She became such a problem to CTMI that she was sent back to her parents in France at age 16.
- Again she experienced abuse at home – even more so, having upset their church. She decided to leave home and live with friends. Like so many, her sister and parents were then convinced to leave everything and move to Mauritius. They did not even inform Sabrina. She found out after the fact – abandoned in France at age 17. She struggled to make a life for herself and Morgane was born in 2001.
- When Morgane was 3 years old, after 6 years of virtually no contact, her family found her and she was summonsed to Mauritius to sign some family documents that seemed to involve the family disinheriting her. Her sister then kicked her father out of the home using police. (He never joined CTMI. We know of many such cases. We have evidence of CTMI advising their members to separate from “pagan” spouses.) What followed was Sabrina and child also being shown the door and she was left to fend for herself. The church refused help. Then began a campaign to prove her an unfit mother. Inspectors from child protection services were sent regularly to where she was living with non CTMI members. Evidently the inspectors found no evidence against Sabrina but the process was traumatizing.
- She became progressively stressed and physically ill to the point where Morgane moved in with Sabrina's mother and sister. (was this the plan all along?) Sabrina determined to work as best she could to earn enough to buy tickets to leave Mauritius with her child. She sought the assistance of a lawyer but could not afford his services.

- Eventually she fell so ill she was forced to leave for better treatment in France with help from a pastor in Reunion. Her family convinced Morgane that she could not go back to France with Sabrina as her poor health and having no family or support, rendered her ability to be a mother precarious. Eventually she was forced to leave Mauritius alone.
 - Upon recovery from severe kidney infection, Sabrina sought to secure the return of Morgane to France. It was then that all communication was shut down now she has since been involved in a desperate attempt to get her child back with her. Sabrina has her child's birth certificate and now expired passport. Morgane is thus in Mauritius without any legal status. Sabrina naturally fears a similar process to the Alladee case. Or that legal status would be achieved through arranged marriage, as has happened in previous cases.
 - Sabrina fears that Morgane has been "brainwashed" against her and that she increasingly sees Sabrina's sister (who has no children) as her mother. Many in the church actually think Morgane is her child.
 - Sabrina, after struggling to reintegrate in France with no networks and having been in a different culture for years, is now gainfully employed, has accommodation, and has prepared a room for Morgane.
- Sabrina sent many appeals with evidence to various cult bodies and the French Justice system and ambassador in Mauritius without satisfactory response. She became very discouraged.
- However, recently a door suddenly opened and French justice have opened a case. Sabrina and Morgane's father have been interviewed by police. Evidence has been collated and a file has been submitted to a judge.
- Family in Mauritius have been informed of legal proceedings. After years of deliberate silence they are suddenly appealing "let's forgive and let bygones be bygones". She has requested information regarding Morgane's schooling at Morning Star from Audrey Hardy with no response.
- Sabrina recently shared her story on Europe 1 radio. She is relentlessly pursuing a mother's right to engage with her own child who has been "captured" in body and mind by CTMI.
