

## Miki's "Apostolic Gospel Foundation" in Pastors' Conferences

In the latest of a string of hilarious reports penned by the mistress of propaganda, Report 2 from the Big Bulawayo Leaders and Pastors Conference starts off with Miki going to the front of the hall and opening the meeting.

Sadly one could summarise the content of what Miki teaches in 15-18 sessions onto one page!! And its always the same message!!

2. The church today is lukewarm and full of sin and trouble
3. You as pastors are part of that church guilty of trying to be in charge on your own, prosperity heresies and dryness
4. You need to repent and receive the revelation of "this gospel"
5. This can only be done if you are part of us who are founded/begotten in this gospel

And if Audrey's commentaries are anything to go by hundreds of vulnerable and perhaps unsuspecting pastors buy into this carefully weaved web of deceit.

**I repeat Extracts (some mentioned by CPG above) that align from Edgewood Durban 2009**

**"** Jesus is coming back soon... and it is our responsibility to bring the right and true gospel to the Church."

This violates so many scriptures!!!

The gospel is the power of God for **salvation**. (Romans 1:16). Is the church unsaved??

Paul did NOT preach the gospel where it had already been preached lest he build on another's foundation. (Romans 15:20) . The church by definition is the body of God's called out ones - those who have embraced the true gospel of the cross. (**NOT** Miki's mystical experience of identifying in our hearts with the cross – self crucifixion version!!!)

“ We will have sincere people that can be trusted around us, who are ready to give their lives for us, as we are for them. It won't be just a covering or a fellowship any longer... but true relationships in the spirit instead. We will discover what true team spirit and teamwork are... “The Lord needs to mould and break us for us to come to the place where we **open our lives, our churches, our ministries, to someone else**, says Miki. The place is quite still and quiet, with the odd nodding head, and looks of understanding dawning in people's eyes.

We wonder who that “someone else” might be???? (We also wonder how Audrey can see into the whole audience's eyes?!)

“ He adds that if God is giving some leaders here the faith to believe and trust Him today, and the Holy Spirit is giving them the testimony in their hearts that what is being shared shared is the truth, it would be a shame to close the door. It would be sad for them not to walk through the door and enter into what God has in store for them. “You are not sitting here by chance... NO! If today is your day... go through the door, and He will help you and give you the grace to build relationships with those carrying the same gospel...” He encourages them look for those people, and to unite their hearts with them. “I know you have programs but it's more important at this time in your life to put your programs on hold... to stop, to be ready to sit, and find time to hear from those who are already begotten in the gospel,” says Miki again with a heart of grace.

Again a blatant and manipulative coercion to enter through CTMI's door and join those with the revelation of the gospel because that would be obedience to the Holy Spirit!

“ Miki urges them not to leave this place and just move on, thinking it was great... But to be humble enough to acknowledge their need for help, even if they have been a pastor for twenty years; not to take things the wrong way but to let Him remove the veil and enable them to see His plan and purpose for their lives, to humble themselves and accept help. He encourages them to desire the type of relationship he has been speaking about... to unite their hearts with men that carry the gospel...
