Trans World Radio

This is the world's largest Christian radio network with a strong and long standing, biblically sound reputation!

Rev Bob Kraft kindly alerted us to the following statements in CTMI newsletters:

"• Good News for Africa

An audio CD with 36 messages of 30-minutes in MP3 format was compiled to distribute to radio stations. Beginning in South Africa, the first series of Good News for Africa has opened doors to some very large Christian media outlets including Trans-World Radio (TWR). A second English compilation is being put together while the Radio team in Curepipe is working on French, Swahili, and Portuguese versions.

• Trans-World Radio – Kenya

The first Good News for Africa is already being broadcast on two FM stations in Northern Kenya. Even more exciting, TWR will soon be broadcasting messages in English and Swahili, recorded at CTMI's annual Regional Conferences in Nairobi, on another 3 FM stations and a number of local partner stations. These will also go out via satellite to other TWR stations in the region. More details in the next issue...

I (Gilbert Grant – CTMI media director) recently reviewed a series in English, with Swahili interpretation, recorded in Nairobi in 2004, where Miki, Peter and Stephen shared. I can tell you that seldom have I heard the gospel imparted in such a simple, yet effective way. We cannot allow such revelatory preaching to gather dust in a cupboard; we must do our best to make it available to the widest possible audience! As a start, these messages are now on TV in Burundi, and are being broadcast on a number of stations by Trans World Radio in Kenya and across the region."

We sent these extracts with a list of verified concerns about CTMI to TWR headquarters in USA. A senior official, Bob Hall, replied with appreciation and informed the Africa Marketing and Programming Director, Rev Brent Bartlett. Brent phoned us and requested as much information as possible.

We have just heard from Brent to inform us that after a full investigation TWR officially want to communicate the following:

- They have never broadcasted any CTMI programmes!
- They have been approached in SA and Kenya by CTMI and turned down the applications because of "concerns" (This was long before we sent them any information)

It therefore seems clear that the newsletter references are carefully crafted lies to keep the members blindly excited and reinforced in the belief that God is doing "amazing things" through their leaders. (A bit like Audrey's statement that the Durban conference was attended by 100 pastors from 50 churches when photographs and witnesses who attended told a very different story) (And we are repeatedly accused of lying?! After more than two years of asking we are still waiting for one example with evidence! 🙄)

We are indeed grateful for this verification from a worldwide, formidable Christian organisation.
